**1. NSW Parliament House Forums**

Over 80 persons attended an informative Forum on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2009, where Pastor Keith Piper spoke on ways to win Muslims for Christ. Four Muslim converts to Jesus Christ shared their new faith in Jesus Christ as Saviour.

### 6. Hypocritical Attacks by Gordon Moyes
